Purpose

To educate and spiritually form persons entering United Methodist Ministry in a retreat setting. In 2008 the course of study offerings will be United Methodist Doctrine and Polity United Methodist History which will meet the requirement of the General Board of Higher Education and Ministry and the *Book of Discipline*. Participants will choose to enroll in either United Methodist Doctrine and Polity or United Methodist History.

THE EXPERIENCE

This will be a residential event with all participants residing at Mt. Sequoyah Center.

The four components of the week are:

- **Worship:** Experiences of worship in the Wesleyan and United Methodist tradition.
- **Exploration Groups:** Exploration of how United Methodist Doctrine, Polity and History forms United Methodist preaching, teaching, music and youth ministry.
- **Courses:** 30 hour courses during the event with required reading prior to September 7. Participants sign up for one course.

- **Life Together:** This experience will provide opportunities of fellowship, sharing and caring. An open forum will offer opportunities for questions and dialogue concerning appointed ministry in the United Methodist Church.
